The Jubilee Garden will be hosting an "Open Garden" after the parade at the Blue Mound Fall Festival until 2:00 pm.
- Jeff Martin and Gary Niemeyer donated fresh sweet corn for the last 2 weeks.
- Shannon Houser donated 7 cases of canned goods.
- Elwin United Methodist Church donated a grocery cart overflowing with cereal, soup, etc.
- The Decatur Caterpillar Union delivered a donation check of \$920.

- Due to a storm, the power went out in Blue Mound about 12:45 pm on Thursday, June 29th and did not come back on until about 11:00 pm. Friday, June 30th. The walk-in cooler was empty at the time. We were able to save all the frozen items, as most were in the walk-in freezer or freezers that were full.

- The Back to School program is set for the first 2 Saturdays in August the 5th and the 12th.
